Badge Positioning and Conditions

- 25.1. The following list is for Education, Field, Air Activities and Instructor badges, which shall be worn only on AAL Uniform. No badge may be worn unless a valid Authority to Wear has been issued and is in the member's possession.
- 25.2. The list is intended as a *QUICK LOCATION* listing and will indicate where the particular badge is located on the uniform.
- 25.3. When you have located the Badge etc and where it is worn, refer to the uniform diagrams in <u>Plates 3 and 4</u> for *EXACT LOCATION*.

- 25.5. On the Junior Cadet Uniform badges are worn in rows of five (5) on the sleeve.
- 25.6. On Cadet and Senior Uniform badges are worn in rows of five (5) on the sleeve.
- 25.7. Instructor Badges Location Conditions
 - Assistant Left arm
 - Squadron Left arm
 - Senior Left arm
 - Major Left arm
 - Master Left arm
 - Physical Activities Left arm Must be 16 years or older to hold
 - First Aid Left arm
 - Life Saving Left arm
- 25.8. Subject to paragraph 24.5.1 of Section 17 of the Australian Air League Inc Manual, where a member is entitled to wear more than one Instructor's Badge, they shall be worn side by side. In order to determine which badge is worn to the front of the sleeve when worn with another Instructor's Badge, they shall be worn from sleeve front to sleeve rear as follows:
 - First Aid
 - Life Saving
 - AAL Instructor
 - Physical Activities Class 1 or Class 2
- 25.9. The AAL Diploma General badge and the AAL Diploma Aviation badge may be worn together. If a recipient is entitled to wear the AAL Diploma Gold badge, then this shall be worn in lieu of the other AAL Diploma badges.

- Where one AAL Diploma badge is worn, it shall be positioned by the wearer to the right of the button on their left breast pocket flap.
- Where two AAL Diploma badges are worn, they shall be positioned by the wearer in order that the AAL Diploma General badge is positioned to the left of the button on the left breast pocket flap. The AAL Diploma Aviation badge is to be positioned by the wearer to the right of the button on the left breast pocket flap.
